BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that each bank designated as a depository for such funds or monies shall furnish the Forest Preserve District of Kane County with a copy of all bank statements which it is required to furnish to the Auditor of Public Accounts or to the Comptroller of the Currency; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if such funds or monies are deposited in any bank herein designated as a depository, the amounts of such deposits shall not exceed seventy-five percent (75%) of the capital stock and surplus of such bank and the Treasurer of the Forest Preserve District of Kane County shall not be discharged from responsibility for any such funds or monies deposited in any bank in excess of such limitation. RESOLUTION NO. FP-R-01-10-1975 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACQUISITION OF LANDS BY PURCHASE OR EMINENT DOMAIN THE SUMMERS FAMILY TRUST PROPERTY, LOCATED IN BIG ROCK TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Forest Preserve District of Kane County, Illinois is organized and existing under an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois entitled "An Act to Provide for the Creation and management of Forest Preserve Districts" approved June 27, 1913, as amended; and

WHEREAS, it has been deemed advisable, necessary and in the best interests of said Forest Preserve District that the Board of Commissioners of said Forest Preserve District acquire additional lands for Forest Preserve purposes, which said lands, together with all lands heretofore acquired, will not exceed 55,000 acres.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That it is hereby determined by the Board of Commissioners of the Kane County Forest Preserve District that a Forest Preserve should be laid out, established, enlarged, constructed and/or otherwise maintained on certain real property hereinafter described, said real property being located within the corporate boundaries of the Forest Preserve District of Kane County, Illinois and that said Forest Preserve be used, occupied, improved, maintained and developed for Forest Preserve purposes in a manner necessary and convenient for public use.

2. That it is hereby determined by the Board of Commissioners of the Kane County Forest Preserve District that it is necessary and desirable that the Forest Preserve District of Kane County, Illinois, shall acquire title to or any interest in and possession of the following described real property for the foregoing purpose, which said real property is necessary required and needed for such Forest Preserve and such Forest Preserve purposes as legally described in Exhibit A, incorporated herein by reference.

3. That the Board of Commissioners of the Kane County Forest Preserve District direct the President of the District, or his delegates(s), be authorized, empowered and directed to negotiate for, and in behalf of, the Forest Preserve District of Kane County, Illinois with the owner or owners, and other parties having an interest herein, of the hereinabove real property for the purchase thereof by the Forest Preserve District of Kane County, Illinois, upon such terms and conditions as the District's Executive Committee shall approve, provided, however, that the purchase price shall not exceed the fair cash market value thereof as determined by the appraisal method required by law.

4. In the event that the President of the Forest Preserve District of Kane County, Illinois is unable to agree with the owner or owners, and other parties having an interest therein of said real property described in Paragraph 2 of this resolution, as to the compensation to be paid, the title or any interest in and possession to said real property may be acquired by the Forest Preserve District of Kane County, Illinois under the provisions of the eminent domain laws of the Sate of Illinois. The Board of Commissioners of the Kane County Forest Preserve District hereby authorizes the President of the District and the District's attorney, with the consent of the Forest Preserve Commission of the District, to institute proceedings in any Court of competent jurisdiction to acquire title to or any interest in and possession of property for said Forest Preserve District of Kane County, Illinois in accordance with the eminent domain laws of the State of Illinois.

EMPLOYEE HOUSING.

PRESENTATION OF EMPLOYEE HOUSING PROGRAM. Executive Director Meyers stated that over 1 year ago the Housing Committee was established to review the Districts structures and houses. The Committee consisted of Commissioners Frasz, Kenyon and Ford. The Committee visited each structure and gave a recommendation to the Planning and Utilization Committee and a modified recommendation to the Executive Committee which both approved the recommendations. The goal is to clean up and have a clear concise housing policy for employees and staff.

-Motion by Frasz, seconded by Mitchell, to approve the Employee Housing Program; motion carried.

STRUCTURE REMOVALS.

REQUEST APPROVAL TO PROCEED WITH BUILDING STRUCTURE REMOVALS. The Housing Sub Committee recommends the following five (5) houses be removed; Burnidge 1, Campton, Glenwood Park, Leroy Oakes and Voyageur's Landing. Commissioner Frasz commented that it was obvious that some of the houses should be kept and some were to be demolished and a few were questionable, those houses will be revisited.

- Motioned by Commissioner Allan, seconded by Commissioner Leonberger, to remove Burnidge 1 and vote on it separately; motion withdrawn.

Commissioner Mitchell stated that the Committees have reviewed this property and that it should be removed. The biggest issue is the barn and the animals, the resident has animals on the property that have damaged the trees and one of the animals runs free.

Discussion continued with staff recommending placing a trail along the drive of this property for walking and hiking along with a pavilion this trail will complete the trail around the lake. The employee will be given the opportunity to move into another house on District property. The present house is in the back of the preserve and difficult for someone to find if needed. This is a long term employee that has taken good care of the property and is a benefit to the District. The house is in good shape and does not need to be removed. Committee should be looking at preserving the resources of the District and keep this property.
