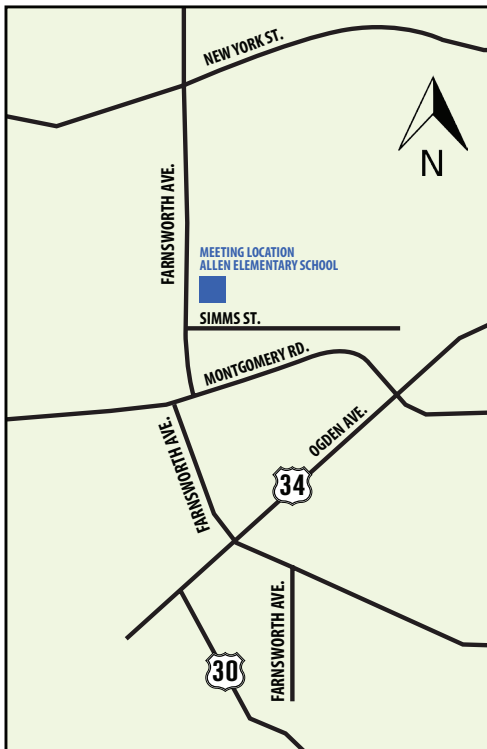

The City of Aurora initiated the Farnsworth Avenue Feasibility Study to evaluate potential future improvement needs to the Farnsworth Avenue Corridor from New York Street on the north to US 30 on the south. This section of Farnsworth Avenue is part of the Strategic Regional Arterial (SRA) roadway network for northeastern Illinois identified by the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP). The Feasibility Study is taking a comprehensive look at existing roadway conditions, safety and capacity issues and future transportation needs.

The City of Aurora has scheduled this Public Information Meeting to present the Feasibility Study process and results, to seek input from stakeholders on the transportation issues and concerns for the Farnsworth Avenue Corridor, as well as potential future improvements. There are no planned improvements at this time.

The meeting will be conducted in an open house format, meaning that interested persons may visit anytime between 4:00 and 7:00 p.m. Attendees will have the opportunity to review exhibits, provide comments and meet with the City of Aurora and consultant representatives on a one-on-one basis. Comments may be submitted at the Public Information Meeting, or can be sent to the City of Aurora at the address below.
