GENEVA, IL — The Forest Preserve District of Kane County invites homeschool students and their parents to join us for “Nature Explorations for Homeschool Families.”

Each month, we’ll explore a different topic at a different forest preserve. Activities focus on ages 5-10, but all ages are welcome to attend this popular program.

December’s theme is “Winter Birds.” The program meets Tuesday, Dec. 15, from 10-11:30 a.m. at Johnson’s Mound Forest Preserve in Elburn. Johnson’s Mound is located at 41W600 Hughes Rd., Elburn.

In January, the theme is “Snow!” and will be held at Tekakwitha Woods Forest Preserve. The preserve is located at 35W076 Villa Marie Rd., St. Charles.

In February, we’ll focus on evergreens. The program will be at LeRoy Oakes Forest Preserve, 37W370 Dean St., St. Charles. Meet at the Great Western Trail on the south side of the street.
