Paul Wolff Campground closes for the season on Oct. 31

GENEVA, IL — Don't miss your chance to camp one more time — Paul Wolff Campground closes for the season on Monday, Oct. 31, at noon.

Owned and operated by the Forest Preserve District of Kane County, Paul Wolff Campground is located within the 600-acre Burnidge Forest Preserve in Elgin. Expanded last year, the Campground includes 90 improved, vehicle campsites complete with 50-amp service, water access, parking pads and fire rings. Five equestrian camp sites and 10 primitive, tents-only camp sites are also available. Primitive camp sites do not have electricity.

Enjoy fall color along the 9 miles of trails, including a 2.25-mile, multi-purpose limestone trail suitable for hiking, biking or equestrian use. While firewood is not allowed to be brought into the campground due to state ordinance, firewood is available for purchase from the campground office at \$5 per bundle.

Daily fees for improved camp sites are \$15 for Kane County residents and \$25 for non-residents. Primitive/non-electric camp sites are \$10 per day for residents, \$15 for nonresidents. All camp sites are available on a first-come, first-served basis; reservations are not taken.

The campground is located at 38W235 Big Timber Rd., Elgin. For information and conditions, call the Forest Preserve District of Kane County camping hotline at (630) 444-1200.

Paul Wolff Campground will reopen next year on Tuesday, May 1, 2012.
