Paul Wolff Campground opens April 29 for season

GENEVA IL— Calling all recreational campers — Paul Wolff Campground opens for the season on Friday, April 29.

“After our long recent winter I know the opening of the campground is a welcome sign of spring,” said Forest Preserve Executive Director Monica Meyers. “We are opening the campground a couple days early this year to allow the camping public to take full advantage of our opening weekend,” she said.

Located within Burnidge Forest Preserve, Paul Wolff Campground covers nearly 600 acres of rolling hills and woodlands. It contains 9 miles of hiking trails, fully stocked fish ponds, a picnic shelter, and a climbing rock. Expanded last year, the Campground includes 89 improved, vehicle campsites complete with 50-amp service, water access, parking pads and fire rings. Five equestrian camp sites and 10 primitive, tents-only camp sites are also available. Primitive camp sites do not have electricity and are available only on weekends.

Daily fees for the improved vehicles campsites are \$15 for Kane County residents and \$25 for non-residents. Primitive/non-electric camp sites are \$10 per day for residents, \$15 for nonresidents. Paul Wolff Campground is open through October 1.

Please note, due to state restrictions on the transport of firewood, outside firewood is not permitted to be brought in to Paul Wolff Campground. Firewood is available for purchase on site at the Campground registration office.
