Dip into August with Forest Preserve Creek Walk

GENEVA, IL — Enjoy the cool and watery world of creeks with the family “Creek Walk” program on Aug. 16.

Naturalists will guide participants as they wade through Tyler Creek and see aquatic life up close and personal. The walk will begin at the Lower Shelter in the Tyler Creek Forest Preserve and will last from 10 - 11 a.m. The cost is \$5 per person or \$20 per family of four or more.

Shorts and waterproof shoes are a must! This program is for creek walkers ages 5 and up and adults must accompany children into the water.

“There’s nothing like wading in a cool creek on a hot summer day!” said Forest Preserve District Nature Programs Manager Valerie Blaine. “Our naturalists will show kids lots of cool life forms that live in the water, and point out how important a clean habitat is for these aquatic creatures.” Blaine said.
