**Homeschool nature program to explore seasons and cycles**

GENEVA, IL — Seasons and cycles are next-up for our monthly “Homeschool Explorations” nature program series.

This programs focus on a different topic each month, at a different forest preserve. The March 23 program is from 10-11:30 a.m. at Tyler Creek Forest Preserve, 401 Davis Rd. in Elgin.

“Homeschool Explorations” activities are designed for kids ages 5-10, but all ages are welcome to attend. Registration for each session is \$2 per person or \$8 for a family of four or more. Advance registration is required. Fee assistance is also available upon request.

“March is a great time to explore the outdoors searching for signs of spring,” said Naturalist Jaclyn Olson. “During this program we’ll hopefully find sprouting plants, hear frogs singing, and locate a few birds that have returned from their migration as well as other signs that winter has finally ended,” she said.

Future topics and preserves include “Snails & Slugs” at Les Arends in Batavia on April 28 and “Snakes & Turtles” on May 16 at Burnidge Forest Preserve in Elgin.
