**Experience the Fox River by Kayak during Sept. 9 nature program**

GENEVA, IL — Join us for a half-day paddling adventure kayaking along the Fox River, on Saturday, Sept. 9, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at Glenwood Park Forest Preserve in Batavia.

If you've always wanted to learn to kayak, and are intrigued with the idea of exploring our local river treasures by boat, this program is for you. This is designed as a beginner's introduction to kayaking, followed by a naturalist-guided tour of the Fox River.

Participants will receive dry-land instruction on basic kayaking techniques from a professional kayaking instructor, prior to taking to the water. After paddling and investigating the river for three hours, participants will be shuttled back to the put-in at Glenwood Park Forest Preserve.

Advance registration is required. This program is for ages 12 and up. Registration by Aug. 25 is required. The fee is \$79/person and includes kayak, flotation device, paddle rental, professional instruction and guide.
