Traditional cultures have names for each month’s full moon, signifying important natural events of the season. We’ll enjoy a walk in the woods — even if the skies are cloudy — on these monthly night hikes.

The first night hike, “Worm Moon,” takes place on Saturday, March 31, from 7:30-8:30 p.m. at Creek Bend Nature Center, located within LeRoy Oakes Forest Preserve at 37W700 Dean St., St. Charles.

The second night hike, “Pink Moon,” is on Sunday, April 29, from 8-9 p.m. at Johnson’s Mound Forest Preserve, located at 41W600 Hughes Rd., Elburn.

The third night hike, “Flower Moon,” takes place on Tuesday, May 29, from 8:30-9:30 p.m. at Brewster Creek Forest Preserve, located at 6N921 IL Rte. 25, St. Charles.
