GENEVA, IL — Learn the lore, legends and science of the moon on the Forest Preserve District of Kane County’s night-hike series for all ages.

Traditional cultures have names for each month’s full moon, signifying important natural events of the season. We’ll enjoy a walk in the woods — even if the skies are cloudy — during these monthly night hikes.

Forest Preserve District naturalists lead these informative hikes:

The first night hike, “Strawberry Moon,” takes place on Wednesday, June 27, from 8:30-9:30 p.m., at Camp Tomo Chi-Chi Knolls, located at 40W095 Freeman Rd., Gilberts.

The second night hike, “Buck Moon,” is Friday, July 27, from 8:15-9:15 p.m., at LeRoy Oakes Forest Preserve, located at 37W700 Dean St., St. Charles.

The third night hike, “Sturgeon Moon,” takes place on Sunday, Aug. 26, from 7:30-8:30 p.m., at Johnson’s Mound Forest Preserve, located at 41W600 Hughes Rd., Elburn.
