**Attend a travelogue on the Dry Tortugas, Feb. 2**

GENEVA, IL — The Forest Preserve District of Kane County invites area seniors to join us for our free monthly “Senior Stroll” program on Thursday, Feb. 2, featuring a travelogue on Florida’s Dry Tortugas.

On the first Thursday of each month, Forest Preserve naturalists lead a leisurely walk through a Kane County forest preserve. In the winter months, we move indoors for special nature presentations.

During the Feb. 2 “Senior Stroll,” Naturalist Josh Libman will share the story of his recent adventure to the Dry Tortugas, off the coast of Florida. Josh will use photographs, maps and field guides to tell the story of this culturally and ecologically significant area. This program takes place from 10-11:30 a.m.
