Forest Preserve offers outdoor survival program

GENEVA, IL — If you had to, could you survive on your own in the woods?

That's right — without your iPhone, without Netflix, without your microwave or your laptop? Find out what gear is essential if you're ever stranded, with our wild new nature program, "Survivor! Do You Have What It Takes?" The program is offered Saturday, May 7, from 10 a.m. to noon at Tekakwitha Woods Forest Preserve in St. Charles.
