Trail resurfacing work scheduled for Virgil Gilman and Great Western Trails

GENEVA, IL — Users of the Virgil Gilman Trail in Sugar Grove and Great Western Trail in St. Charles and Campton Hills are asked to be aware of temporary trail closures for both systems in July.

Trail resurfacing work is scheduled on the Virgil Gilman Trail from Bliss Road to Waubonsee Drive in Sugar Grove. The trail will be primarily open during construction but with intermittent closures. Resurfacing begins Friday, July 8, and is expected to last through Monday, July 20.

On the Great Western Trail, plan for intermittent closures from the trail head at Dean Street in St. Charles through Brown Road in Campton Hills. Resurfacing work is scheduled for Thursday, July 14 through Friday, July 22.

The Forest Preserve District of Kane County maintains the trail systems. The District asks trail users to be mindful of the possibility of construction traffic and workers on or around the trails. Schedules are subject to change due to weather and other circumstances.
