**Share feedback on preserve improvements during Open House meetings**

GENEVA, IL — The Forest Preserve District of Kane County invites the public to share feedback on proposed preserve improvements at any of several open house meetings.

The goal of the meetings is to help revise the District's five-year *Master Plan*. The *Master Plan* details and prioritizes all capital and natural resources improvements in the forest preserves. Staff will be on hand to describe proposed improvements and solicit comments and ideas. Maps depicting proposed improvements will be on display. Input from the meetings will help develop the District's guide and vision for the future.

Kane County residents are encouraged to attend and share input on programs and amenities they would most like to see in the forest preserves. The meetings are in open-house format, and attendees may stay for as long or as little as they like. Complimentary light refreshments will be served. Each *Master Plan* Open House focuses on preserves regionally located near each respective meeting site.
